#### Task Description

Students will complete a Moodle skills test in their History period on 16<sup>th</sup> May 2024

The skills test will take place in the Technology Centre. Students will need to have their Moodle log in and make sure they can access the year 8 History Moodle page prior to this date.

The skills test will be based on the topic: Medieval Europe and general Historical Skills such as:

- Identification of primary and secondary sources
- Interpretation of sources
- Context of sources
- Perspective of sources

### **Details of Submission**

- The skills test will consist of 40 questions. Students will have 45 minutes to complete the task.
- Students are expected to meet their classroom teacher at their timetabled classroom, where the roll will be marked. Students will then be ushered to the technology centre.
- Students will need to have their Moodle log in and make sure they can access the Year 8 History Moodle page prior to the day.

The answers students provide will save automatically. Students will need to press submit when they finish the test.

### **Assessment Procedures**

All students should be fully aware of the School Assessment Procedures for their year group. These were provided at the beginning of the school year and are available off the school website under the Learning Tab for each year group

### **Feedback provided**

- The task will be returned to students immediately. Students will be able to see their mark on the day, but will be provided correct/incorrect answers within two weeks.

- Students can clarify or seek further feedback by arranging to meet with their teacher.
