Task Description

Students are required to participate in a range of practical class activities pertaining to **Touch Football** to develop their skills – technical and tactical. Students will be assessed in class, based on participation, skill, technique as well as defensive and attacking strategies.

Students will be required to:

- Demonstrate defensive structure and skills
- Demonstrate attacking structure and skills
- Demonstrate skills specific to touch football –passing, catching, running on to the ball (hit up), playing the ball (Dumping)
- Participate in all lessons, with the correct equipment and demonstrate encouraging and supportive communication while interacting with others.
